

Holy Family Manor COVID-19 Update 5-13-2020

**Dear Family and Friends of Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care,**

We at Holy Family Manor want to take this opportunity to recognize the dedicated staff for their excellence in mitigating this pandemic. They are our heroes on the front lines protecting our residents and each other. As you are all aware, Holy Family Manor opened our COVID-19 positive isolation unit last month and we continue with routine and sample testing of residents and staff.

We are writing to provide you an update from our May 8, 2020 communication. On 5-12-2020, we had 2 new resident cases of COVID-19 on our rehabilitation unit who were immediately moved from our triage area to our COVID-19 isolation wing. Today we received 2 more positive residents from the triage wing in our COVID unit. In total, we will have a census of 7 residents occupying our COVID unit. The Holy Family Pavilion of floors 1, 2, and 3 remain without COVID-19.

We have received a total of 3 positive staff results. The symptomatic staff are isolating at home. The asymptomatic COVID-19 staff have the option of working the COVID-19 isolation unit for which they enter/exit directly to the COVID-19 unit. We will continue to communicate any new cases of COVID-19 and weekly updates on our status. We continue to test all new admissions and as needed to mitigate any potential spread of this virus. We continue with all of our previously reported infection control protocols including but not limited to daily monitoring of residents and staff, closed to visitors, frequent disinfecting, ongoing education, etc.

We appreciate the patience of all our residents and families during this difficult time of social distancing and continue to do our best to keep our residents connected with their loved ones through use of social media.
