Holy Family Manor COVID-19 Update 5-18-2020

Dear Family and Friends of Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care,

Greetings! I am again writing to provide you an update on the activities within Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care. As we continue to deal with COVID-19 in our facility, we will be providing you with ongoing updates to ensure you are kept aware of all we are doing to combat the virus and care for your loved ones.

As we continue to be proactive, we completed testing of all residents on McShea over the weekend and received 5 additional positive results today. They were immediately placed in isolation. Our current total of COVID-19 positive residents is 21. There were 2 additional positive results among staff. They are isolating at home. The current total of Holy Family Manor staff is 11. Please be assured we are continuing our testing protocols and will regularly perform tests on residents and staff.

As we reported on May 15, 2020, The Holy Family Pavilion (floors 1, 2, and 3) and Grace Mansion Personal Care remain free of COVID-19. We continue to keep all infection control measures in force throughout our facility.

We invited the Pennsylvania Health Care Coalition to visit our facility today to meet with our team and discuss infection control measures. I am pleased to report that the visiting team affirmed our procedures to address COVID-19 infections and assured us that we have implemented best practices in infection control.

We continue to have a pause on new admissions to our facility. Our team is hard at work following all infection control measures and caring for our residents. We will also continue to communicate any new cases of COVID-19, as well as provide weekly updates to you. We appreciate the patience of all our residents and families during this difficult time of social distancing and continue to do our best to keep our residents connected with their loved ones through use of social media.
