Holy Family Manor COVID-19 Update 5-22-2020

Dear Family and Friends of Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care,

Greetings! I wanted to share the latest information about COVID-19 at Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care. As you know, we have had an uptick in cases over the past two weeks, which we have been reporting to you in our resident/family communications. We have aggressively followed all infection control measures, such as increased testing of residents and staff to ensure we identify any new cases as soon as possible. Holy Family Manor Pavilion and Grace Mansion Personal Care remain free of COVID-19 cases.

We continue to hold off on new admissions for the time being. Our staff is focusing on caring for our residents and meeting their needs. We continue to operate an isolation wing on McShea for any resident who tests positive for COVID-19. As you know, this isolation wing is completely separated from the rest of McShea Rehabilitation Unit and has its own staff to care for the residents. Staff who work on the isolation wing are not permitted to work on any other resident floors at Holy Family Manor. They also enter and exit the facility through a separate door on McShea to limit any exposure.

Here is the full breakdown of COVID-19 cases (from start to now):

Number of resident cases: 23 Number of resident deaths: 5 Number of staff cases: 14

We are including resident deaths that are confirmed or suspected to involve COVID-19. The number of staff cases includes Holy Family Manor staff, as well as staff from contracted services in the facility. We want to be as transparent as possible, so this information will be included in our weekly updates to you. Holy Family Manor has provided all requested statistics to the Pennsylvania Department of Health and CDC since the start of the pandemic.
