Yesterday, a resident who recently arrived for rehabilitation tested positive for COVID-19. The resident, who was on our McShea Rehabilitation Unit, was immediately placed in our prepared isolation unit, McShea East, and is being well cared for by our designated nurses/ CNAs. As a precaution, we have tested all residents on the McShea Units. This is a part of our aggressive plan to combat COVID-19 and keep our facility as safe as possible.

As you are aware, Holy Family Manor has a separate, contained isolation unit with its own staff and supplies ready to care for any of our residents who test positive for COVID-19. Please be assured that we are following our stringent infection control procedures throughout our facility and report any infection to the Department of Health. We have infection control experts among our staff and we are vigilant with our training and day-to-day practices.

During the week of May 10th, we will celebrate National Nursing Home Week. Despite the continued lockdown, we have activities and celebratory events scheduled to honor our nurses, Certified Nursing Assistants and all staff at Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care who give so much of themselves to care for our residents like they are their own family.
