**Dear Family and Friends of Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care,**

As we end the month of May, I wanted to share the latest information about COVID-19 at Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care. The Holy Family Manor Pavilion and Grace Mansion Personal Care remain free of COVID-19 cases.

Here is the full breakdown of COVID-19 cases:

**Current number of resident cases: 21    Current number of resident deaths: 7    Current number of staff cases: 19**

As explained in last week's update, we are including resident deaths that are confirmed or suspected to involve COVID-19, and the number of staff cases. We want to be as transparent as possible, so this information will be included in our weekly updates to you. Holy Family Manor provides all requested statistics to the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Bethlehem Bureau of Health, and the CDC.

As long as we stay on this course of significant decline in new infections, we will soon begin to plan to welcome you back to visit your loved ones. We are very grateful for your patience and understanding through this pandemic. Not having the ability to visit in person is a heavy burden and keeping in touch through social media and phone calls is not the same. Our Life Enrichment staff members continue to provide one to one activities with residents but we look forward to when our residents can experience the joy and camaraderie of group activities.
