Greetings! I hope you have been enjoying the warm weather we have had this week. Our residents are looking forward to more days of sun and the beautiful season of summer. We have had a busy week with continued COVID-19 testing of residents and staff as a follow-up to our baseline testing that took place on June 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, with the help of the National Guard.

The Pavilion, Grace Mansion, and McShea North remain COVID-19 free. Residents on McShea South with COVID-19 continue to progress in their healing. We will continue to be vigilant in our testing to make sure we identify any new cases of COVID-19. Although we are plateauing, we cannot let down our guard against this virus.

The Pennsylvania Department of Health recently issued new guidelines to re-open long term care facilities in a series of phases. Once Lehigh County reaches the Green Phase, we must wait an additional 28 days before we can open our doors.
