



Holy Family Manor COVID-19 Update 6-5-2020

Dear Family and Friends of Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care,

As we begin the month of June and start of the summer season, I wanted to share the latest information about COVID-19 at Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care. We have had no new cases of resident infections since my last letter to you.

Here is the full breakdown of COVID-19 cases:

Current number of resident cases: 18 Current number of resident deaths: 7 Current number of staff cases: 21

As I said in last week's update, we are beginning to plan for the easing of restrictions on visitors in the coming weeks. Our re-opening plan will be implemented in phases to safely allow visitors to enter the facility. To prepare for this, we requested a medical team from Pennsylvania Emergency Management and the National Guard to test all residents and staff in the facility for us. That testing took place early this week.

I am pleased to report that as a result of our aggressive testing measures, all residents residing on the Pavilion, McShea North and Grace Mansion were negative for COVID-19. Two staff members tested positive, but were asymptomatic. They are quarantining at home at home and may return to work only after two negative tests. McShea South is still set up as an isolation unit for residents recovering from COVID-19.

As part of our plan to prevent new infections, now that we have established a baseline for all residents and staff, we will continue testing a percentage of residents and staff every 10 days. We continue to follow all guidance on testing from the Pennsylvania Department of Health, CDC and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS).

We appreciate your continued patience as we prepare to welcome you back. We will implement a scheduled visitation system to ensure the safety of our residents. I will have more details on this visitation plan in the coming weeks.
