

Holy Family Manor COVID-19 Update 7-1-2020

Dear Family and Friends of Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care,

As we prepare to celebrate the Independence Day holiday, I want to share the news about the wonderful progress we have made in combating COVID-19. Our resident cases continue to decline and our staff cases have significantly decreased- **eighteen staff have recovered.**

Our residents recovering from COVID-19 are in the East Wing of McShea, which will continue to be our designated COVID-19 isolation area. Both North and South McShea are COVID-19 free, as well as the Pavilion side and Grace Mansion Personal Care. I must admit it feels like we have our own Independence Day celebration from COVID! Here is the full breakdown of COVID-19 cases:

Current number of resident cases: 4 Current number of resident deaths: 7 Current number of staff cases: 4

We are slowly introducing group activities for residents with safety protocols in place, including: social distancing, frequent disinfection of all surfaces and resident areas; and daily health screening of residents and staff. We cannot let our guard down against COVID-19. Our top priority is the safety of our residents!
