Dear Family and Friends of Holy Family Manor and Grace Mansion Personal Care,

Greetings! I hope you are enjoying the summer weather and staying safe. Holy Family Senior Living continues to follow recommendations from the Pennsylvania Department of Health and CDC. Our COVID-19 infection control protocols will remain in place, and we will continue to carefully screen all residents and staff for any potential signs of the virus.

I am pleased to report our residents and staff with COVID-19 are recovering and we have not had any new infections for approximately 3-4 weeks. Here is the full breakdown of COVID-19 cases: (no changes from last week):

Current number of resident cases: 3 Current number of resident deaths: 7 Current number of staff cases: 3

As noted in last week's update, our Life Enrichment Department is slowly introducing group activities for residents with safety protocols in place, including: social distancing, frequent disinfection of all surfaces and resident areas; and daily health screening of residents and staff. The health and safety of our residents must always come first! We recognize that visits and interaction with family and friends is important for residents' health, too; however, we are being extremely careful with infection control procedures.
