Greetings and Happy March! I am writing to provide you with an update on the COVID-19 status at Holy Family Senior Living. Holy Family Senior Living has no cases of COVID-19 and all employees have returned from quarantining at home.

Holy Family Senior Living has held eight (8) COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics to ensure all eligible residents and staff who wanted the vaccine had access to receive it. We will continue to provide updates to you as new information becomes available so that you can remain apprised of any future changes to our COVID status, new information about the vaccine and/or updates to the visitation policy.

We are beginning to welcome prescheduled, socially-distanced, in-person visits by family members in a dedicated visitation room on the ground floor. Visitation is limited to 2 persons at a time. Please see our Guidelines for Visitation (copy attached) and our Reopening Plan (posted on our webpage at www.holyfamilysl.org).

Our Life Enrichment staff is in the process of reaching out to families to schedule each in person visit. It is our intention to provide each resident with an in-person visit approximately every 2 weeks. Once the weather becomes warmer, we will begin outdoor patio visits.
