From our Chaplain . . .

During Holy Week, we recall the events leading up to Jesus's death by crucifixion and his resurrection on Easter Sunday. Holy Week has five days of special significance:

I - Palm Sunday where we commemorate Jesus humbly entering Jerusalem riding a donkey to celebrate Passover. He met with crowds who proclaimed him the son of David (Matthew 21:5)

II - Holy Thursday, we recall Jesus's last supper with his Disciples where he instituted the Holy Eucharist which is the central element of Christian worship. Jesus also commissioned the Disciples to serve others following his excellent example of offering himself for us.

III - Good Friday is when we commemorate Jesus's suffering and death on the cross for our salvation.

IV - Holy Saturday, also called Easter Vigil, is the traditional end of Lent.

V - Easter Sunday is the celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus. Luke 24:1-12.

The Resurrection of Jesus is something I can't prove to you. We see this not with the eyes on our *face* but with the eyes of our *faith*. Easter Sunday begins the period of the Easter season when we celebrate Jesus's extraordinary rise from the dead. He is alive. He is with us in our daily lives.
